



Information Reclaim Insurance Hockey Canada

ACCIDENT INSURANCE AND PUBLIC LIABILITY

The document « Security: Team Work », in which you will find information related for members of Insurance Programs and the Hockey Canada Accident Report.

Complete all sections of the Hockey Canada Accident Report (2 pages) and do not forget to have the report signed by the parents if players are under 18 years old (mandatory signature). The section **TEAM INFORMATION** must also be completed and signed by a Team Official (President, Manager, Head-Coach). Ensure that all sections are completed before transmitting the report to Hockey Québec either by fax (**if you have already submitted it to you primary Insurer**) or by courier to **Hockey Québec if you have no primary Insurer**.

With your submission, you must include the duly completed Injury Report along with all original invoices and receipts (if you have no primary insurer), this within 90 days of the accident.

IMPORTANT:

- Only Injury Reports received by Hockey Québec within 90 days of the date of the accident will be accepted.
- Hockey Canada is strictly a supplemental insurer in accordance with the fiduciary program of medical allowances (major medical and dental expenses). If you have access to any other Insurance Program, you must first present your claim to such Insurer. Hockey Canada reimburses fees that are not covered by your Primary Insurance up to the limits set in its policy.
- Hockey Canada does not cover expenses incurred with private MRI/Medical Clinics for hospital services not offered by any Hospital Insurance Plan of a Federal or Provincial plan administered by the province in which the insured resides, whether they are paid or not.
